



Dilation Consent Form

In order to properly assess your eye health we must routinely perform a dilated examination of your eyes. In order for our doctors to perform a thorough eye examination, it is sometimes necessary to dilate your eyes on each visit, and almost always on the first exam.

Dilation may cause blurred vision and glare for some patients for about 4-6 hours. For children, an additional drop is given that may take up to 12 hours to wear off. We will provide temporary sun protection for you to use following the dilation. If you do not receive these glasses from the front desk following your exam please request some. While these glasses help reduce light sensitivity and glare, dilation will cause blurred vision for several hours. The doctors recommend you bring a driver if you do not feel safe driving. Also, it may not be safe to operate heavy machinery or hand tools during this time. You may reschedule the dilation portion of the examination if another day would work better for you.
